

SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- Resistant to scab (gen Vf)
- Susceptible to mildew
- Average to low susceptibility to rosy apple aphid

FRUIT:

- Skin: shiny dark red
- Flesh: firm and fine
- Taste: very good balance between sugars and acidity

STORAGE:

Cold storage: DecemberCA storage: March

USES:

- Suitable for organic orchards
- One of the sweetest scab resistant varieties
- Very important to store the fruit in CA storage for post Christmas sales.
