GROWTH: average to good

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: average
- Susceptible to bitter-pit when the crop load is too weak

SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

Susceptible to scab, mildew and canker

FRUIT:

- Skin: intense red with a little bit of russet
- Flesh: yellow, fine, firm and juicy
- Taste: sweet and sharp with many flavours

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: December
- CA storage: January
