
ORIGIN: Cross of Gala and Jerseymac, Switzerland

MATURITE: 50 days before Golden Delicious, 4 weeks before Gala and 1 week before Akane.

BLOSSOM DATE: rather early

POLLINATED BY:

- Red Idared, Braeburn, Granny Smith
- Malus INRA® Perpetu® Evereste, Malus Golden Gem
- Any other diploid variety with the same blossom date

POLLINATOR FOR:

Golden Delicious, Jonagold, Elstar

TREE TYP: type III (Golden Delicious) with many branches

GROWTH: good

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: good for an early variety
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: low
- Thinning: easy

- Flesh: crisp and juicy
