PICKING DATE: very late (from end October til mid November); 5 weeks after Golden Delicious)

FRUIT SIZE (mm):



BLOSSOM DATE: 2 days before Golden Delicious

POLLINATED BY:

- Any other diploid variety with the same blossom date
- Malus INRA Perpetu® Evereste, Malus INRA Baugene®, Malus Golden Gem

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious) with short interstems

GROWTH: weak as soon as the trees start to produce

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: possible if the crop is too heavy
- Thinning: rather difficult (between Golden Delicious and Gala)

SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- Resistant to scab
- Susceptible to mildew
- Tolerant to rosy apple aphid

FRUIT:

- Skin: rustic aspect, yellow with strong lenticels and typical russetting
- Taste: exceptional eating qualities from February. Both very sweet and very sharp with powerful flavours

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: April
- CA storage: July

USES:

- Very good variety for farm shops late sales
- Very good variety for quality orientated markets (late sales)
- Can be marketed after INRA Belchard® Chanteclerc
- Suitable for organic orchards
