BLOSSOM DATE: as for Granny Smith, 2 days before Golden Delicious

POLLINATED BY:

- Granny Smith, Gala, Red delicious, Idared
- 30% Malus Golden Gem + 70% Malus INRA® Perpetu® Evereste

POLLINATOR FOR: Gala, Golden Delicious, Elstar, Granny Smith

TREE TYPE: Type III (Golden Delicious), with a rather weeping growth

GROWTH: weak to average

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Productivity: very good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: low
- Thinning: relatively easy

SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- Average susceptibility to scab
- Susceptible to bitter pit when the crop is low

FRUIT:

- Skin: very attractive dark red, striped blushed; nearly all the surface of the fruit is coloured.
- Flesh: very firm
- Taste: sweet and sharp, typical of Braeburn

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: March
- CA storage: June

USES:

This sport is used by the growers who want fruit with an excellent colour in order to reduce the number of picks at harvest.
