ORIGIN: sport of Jonagold, Netherland
(Reminder: Jonagold is a cross of Golden Delicious and Jonathan)

PICKING DATE: as for Jonagold (one week before Golden Delicious)

FRUIT SIZE (mm):



BLOSSOM DATE:

- Mid range (1 to 2 days before Golden Delicious)
- Triploid variety

POLLINATED BY:

- Cox, Elstar, Gala, Golden Hornet, Granny Smith, Idared, Red Pippin, Worcester Pearmain
- Any diploid variety with the same blossom date

POLLINATOR FOR: triploid – not suitable as a pollinator

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious)

GROWTH: strong (use rootstocks such as M9 Pajam® 1Lancep, M9 NAKB or M9 T337)

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: average
- Yields: excellent
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: possible after heavy crops
- Thinning: easy

NOTES:

SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- Average susceptibility to scab
- Susceptible to mildew

FRUIT:

- Skin: intense red on 100% of the fruit
- Flesh: juicy, crisp, fine flesh
- Taste: good if the crop load is not too strong

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: February
- CA storage: June

USES:

For fruit growers who need a very dark colour in order to reduce their production costs and to improve their grade-out.
